

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ENTERPRISE NO. 142

BYLAW NO. 02-2021

A BYLAW FOR THE R.M. OF ENTERPRISE TO ESTABLISH A LANDFILL AND
TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF WASTE.

1. This bylaw may be cited as the 'Landfill Bylaw'.
2. The land described as; NW1/4 Sec. 23, Twp 17, Rge.28, W3rd Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan shall be established as the 'Richmond Landfill'.
3. A Permit to Operate shall be applied for and complied with by the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142.
4. The development, operation and maintenance of the landfill site shall be sole responsibility of the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142.
5. There shall be a Landfill Committee appointed each year; consisting of three (3) members of the council from the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142 and one (1) member of the council from the Village of Richmond. The Landfill Committee may make recommendations for changes to the landfill, deal with problems as they arise and consult on policies for the landfill. All recommendations shall go to the council of the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142, any changes to the landfill shall be by a resolution of council.
6. Hours of operation shall be in the 'Landfill Policy' and no person shall be on the landfill premises outside the hours of operation unless otherwise authorized by the R.M. Administrator or Foreman.
7. A site operator shall be contracted by the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142 and will enforce any bylaws or policies regarding the landfill. All users of the landfill shall see the site operator before any dumping and shall follow instructions given by the site operator. Failure to do so may result in the user being banned from the landfill.
8. Residents of the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142 and the Village of Richmond are permitted to use the landfill.
9. Fees for the disposal of waste shall be set out in the 'Landfill Policy' and are subject to change by a resolution of council.
10. Waste items to be accepted at the landfill shall be set out in the 'Landfill Policy', only those items will be accepted and are subject to change by a resolution of council.
11. On December 31st of each year the Village of Richmond shall pay portion of costs associated with the landfill to the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142, the fee will be reviewed and agreed on by both councils annually.
12. The Municipal Landfill Agreement dated October 7th, 1992 between the R.M. of Enterprise, No. 142 and the Village of Richmond is hereby dissolved.
13. Bylaw No. 2-1992 is hereby repealed.
14. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final reading thereof.
