



LANDFILL POLICY

Introduction

This policy has been designed for the Richmond Landfill located south of Richmond at NW 23-17-28 W3 as a reference for the landfill operator, users and the municipal employees.

Council of the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142, under the recommendations from the Landfill Committee has been revising the permit for the landfill in accordance with legislation under the Ministry of Environment. The goal is to provide R.M. and Village of Richmond ratepayers with a location to dispose of waste and recyclable materials. This policy, fees associated with and materials collected are subject to change at the discretion of council.

Hours of Operation

Summer Hours, in effect from April 1st – November 30th:

Wednesdays 1:00 P.M. CST – 6:00 P.M. CST

Saturdays 1:00 P.M. CST – 5:00 P.M. CST

Winter Hours, in effect from December 1st – March 31st:

Wednesdays 1:00 P.M. CST – 5:00 P.M. CST

Saturdays 1:00 P.M. CST – 5:00 P.M. CST

Regulations

1. Landfill users must see the site operator before any dumping. The site operator will indicate where materials are to be dumped.
2. Materials to be accepted include: Household waste, personal demolition projects, clean wood, recycling, scrap metal, metal appliances and chemical jugs.
3. Refer to Exhibit 'A' from Triways Disposal Services for a list of prohibited items.
4. All household waste must be bagged.
5. Refer to Exhibit 'B' from Triways Disposal Services for a list of acceptable items to recycle.
6. Clean wood and yard waste will be accepted into the clean wood pile.
7. Scrap metal items with mixed materials (such as plastic and wood) will be accepted at the discretion of the site operator.
8. Appliances will not be accepted unless doors and lids have been removed, as a safety precaution.
9. Chemical jugs and containers must be triple rinsed and bagged (provided at landfill).
10. No contractors and the site operator will turn away loads greater than 10m³.
11. Anyone who does not comply with the regulations may be prohibited from using the landfill.
12. No items shall be removed from the landfill.
13. There will be no access to the landfill outside of hours of operations unless otherwise authorized by the R.M. Administrator.

Fees

As per resolution number #08-23, from the Regular Council Meeting held on January 19th, 2023, as of January 1st, 2023 the R.M. of Enterprise No. 142 no longer charges fees for using the municipal landfill.

A reminder to residents that the acts of burning and dumping waste are illegal. Refer to *The Environment Management and Protection Act of 2010* and *The Environment Management and Protection Regulations of 2015*.
